

FY02 DON Pilot Project Summary

Project Name: Common Access Card Contractor Verification System – (#1227)

Command: DON eBusiness Operations Office

Functional Area Manager (FAM): Manpower & Personnel

Pilot Summary:

This project provides a web-based platform for streamlining the process of issuing the CAC (Common Access Card) to the government contractor population via an electronic DD 1172-2 form, validates authorized government sponsors (Trusted Agents) through PKI credentials on the CAC, and creates an intuitive workflow process that integrates with the current DEERS / RAPIDS environment.

Business Value Added:

- Web-enables DD 1172-2 form and creates an intuitive workflow process to greatly reduce the paper trail
- PKI authentications of government sponsors (Trusted Agents) via the CAC
- Data integration with DEERS / RAPIDS for efficient and accurate processing of contractor-issued CAC's
- Ability to review CAC's issued to government contractor's and revoke cards when necessary
- Creates a contractor's database that facilitates data analysis of the DoD contractor workforce

Other Considerations:

- Project requirements and system reviews have had participation from all military services
- Once completed, the application will be available for use by all Navy and Marine Corps commands
