






Instructions for changing your desktop display setting configuration to 1024 x 768 are as follows:


1) Locate the Display Program within your Windows Control Panel. Do this by selecting "Start", "Settings", "Control Panel" from your Windows Desktop.




2) Double-click on the "Display" Program located within the Control Panel.




2) The following window should now appear before you.




3) Select the "Settings" Tab, write down your current Display Setting configuration (i.e. 800 by 600 pixels, 640 by 480 pixels, etc.) located on the Desktop Slider bar Control, and then change the Desktop Slider Bar control to the "1024 by 768 pixels" setting.



4) Select the "Test" button and then select "OK".



5) Assuming you see the test pattern correctly, select "Yes" and then "OK". If you did not, contact your local computer administrator.



6) You may now continue with the tutorial. To change your Display Settings back to your original configuration upon completion of the tutorial, follow these instructions and substitute your original Display setting (i.e. 800 by 600 pixels, 640 by 480 pixels, etc.) from what you wrote down in step 3.
